NCC Parade

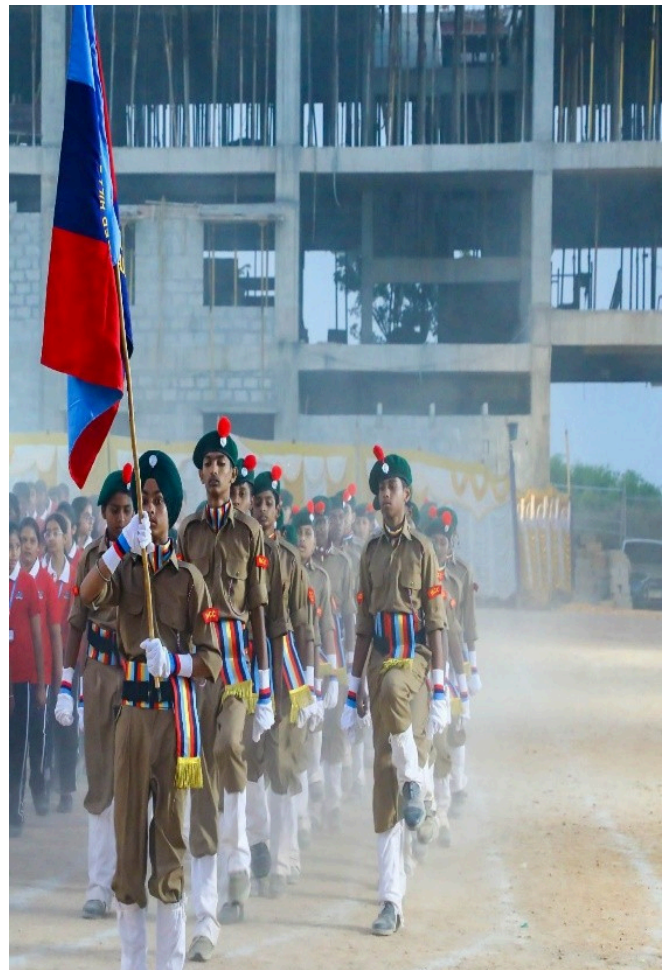
A Tribute to Discipline and Patriotism

Overall, the trip was a joyful experience, leaving students with wonderful memories and happy hearts.



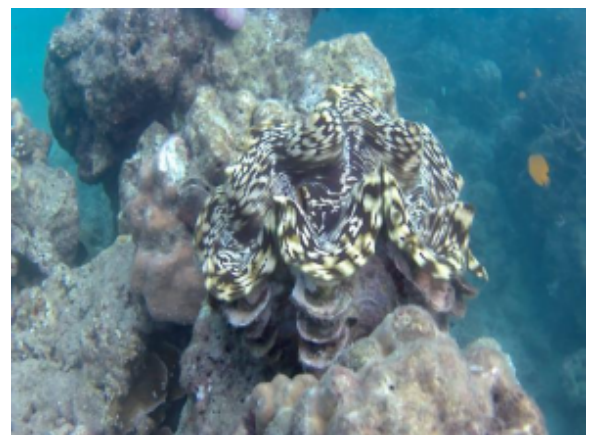


High School Trip to Andaman – An Educational Journey of Discovery

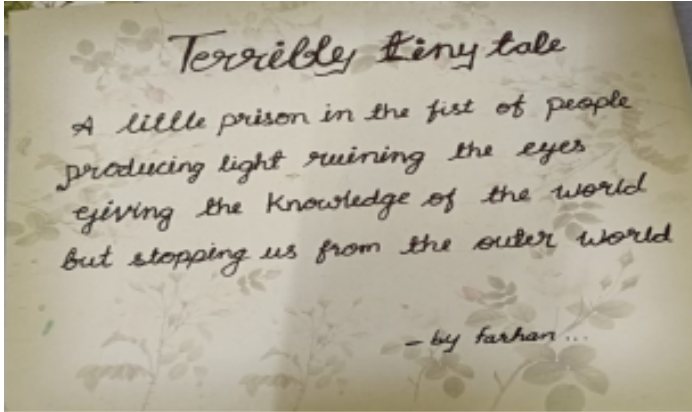
